Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.) Program in Business Administration
(International Program)
For the Academic Year 2025

The National Institute of Development Administration (NIDA) is accepting applications for admission to the Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.) Program in Business Administration (International Program) for the academic year 2025 in the following specializations:

1. Management
2. Marketing
3. Finance
4. Operations Management
5. Management Information Systems
6. Accounting

Note: Only one PhD specialization can be chosen at the time of the application, and the selected specialization cannot be changed after the application form has been submitted.

1. Qualification of Applicants

- 1.1 The applicant must hold a master's degree in any field or major from an accredited academic institution. If the applicant graduated from an institution outside of Thailand, the applicant must obtain a letter from the Bureau of Standards and Evaluation, Office of Higher Education Commission (OHEC), Ministry of Education in Thailand indicating that the applicant's degree is recognized by the OHEC.
- 1.2 Applicants must conform to the requirements of NIDA's current announcement on English proficiency requirements for the International Program students, which is as follows:
 - 1.2.1 If the applicant is not a native English speaker or did not obtained their bachelor's and/or master's degree from an international academic institution in an English-speaking country within the past five years, the applicant must submit one of the following test scores that was taken within the past two years:
 - **Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL)** The minimum score is 550 for the paper-and pencil test, 213 for the computer based test, or 79 for the internet based test.
 - **International English Language Testing System (IELTS)** The minimum score is 6.5 points.

- 1.2.2 Applicants who fail to meet the requirement in 1.2.1 but earn the minimum score required by NIDA, may be accepted into the program, provided that they conform to NIDA's rules on English proficiency.

Note: Applicants can take the TOEFL/ITP administered by NIDA. Applicants who would like to take the TOEFL/ITP exam can contact NIDA's School of Language and Communication for more details.

2. Selection Procedure

- 2.1 Written Examination. Qualified applicants must take either the Graduate Management Admission Test (GMAT) within the past two years and achieve a score of at least 550, or the Business Aptitude Test administered by NIDA.
- 2.2. Interview. Qualified applicants who have passed the written exam will be invited for an interview.

3. Application Procedure

- 3.2 **Online Application** at <http://entrance.nida.ac.th> from now to **April 25, 2025**.
